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Quality of work	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Work is always submitted • Work is consistently completed to the highest standards • Works hard to ensure spelling and grammar is consistently accurate or improving 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Work is always submitted • Work is almost always completed to a high standard • Attempts to improve on spelling and grammar errors in subsequent work 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Work is usually submitted • Work may be rushed with not enough attention to quality • May repeat spelling and grammar errors previously noted 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Work is sometimes or rarely submitted • Work may often be incomplete or of a poor standard • There is little attempt to use correct spellings or grammar
