## Dear Parent/Carer

Since my previous letter where I outlined the plans for students returning to school from March 9<sup>th</sup> and the schedule for mass testing, there has been a significant increase in parents requesting that their child is tested and giving their consent; this now means that it is no longer going to be possible to test two year groups on the same day. Whilst this is extremely disappointing for parents and students we feel that from a safety aspect, the more students that are willing to be tested, the safer our school will be. Previously, with only about a quarter of the school having consented, the majority of students would not have been tested but would still have been required back in school; at least this way, hopefully, the majority of students will be tested making it a much more worthwhile enterprise.

The revised plan (as set out below) will mean that Year II will be tested on March 8<sup>th</sup> as previously agreed; Year 10 on the 9<sup>th</sup>, Year 7 on the 10<sup>th</sup>, Year 8 on the 11<sup>th</sup> and Year 9 on the 12<sup>th</sup>. Students will start school **the following day** after their testing (apart from Year 9 who will start on Monday 15<sup>th</sup> March) at the usual time providing they have not received a positive result.
