
Curriculum Map 2021-22

Key Stage 3:

Students follow two different pathways, Extended and Central

Extended students have an additional lesson of science to allow them to prepare for the opportunity to study for Separate Sciences at GCSE, as well as studying Spanish.

Students in central from each year in Key Stage 3, have the opportunity to develop their literacy or numeracy as an intervention to support equity with their peers when beginning their GCSE's.



In Year 9 students are offered the opportunity to specialise in two Open Bucket subjects in preparation for KS4. After Easter, students will specialise in either Geography or History.

All students begin to study GCSE Mathematics, Religious Studies and Combined Science in Year 9.

Key Stage 4:

Students remain in the Extended and Central curriculum for compulsory subjects. In Year 11, students across both streams are timetabled against each other for English and Maths.

All students will specialise in either Geography or History and continue with study in English Language, English Literature, Mathematics and RE.

Students in Extended choose a language as an option subject and have two open choices.

Students in Central choose three open choices.

Option Blocks are created following a best-fit approach and require a minimum number of students to run.

All students follow Combined Science (Trilogy Specification); some students study for Separate Science as part of their options.
