The Review

Term I saw our students focus on **personal responsibility**. We teach our students about the importance of being accountable for the actions which they have control over, to make wise choices. Students were taught about the value of attending school every day, punctuality and always being equipped for lessons. These are fundamental character traits needed to be successful not only at The Dorcan Academy, but when they enter the world of work. Alongside this year 7 were taught about how to use their knowledge organisers to support their Academic Prep and where they can go if they need support. Years 8 and 9 completed Focus Week where they reviewed their progress from last year and set themselves SMART targets to ensure they make better than expected progress. Year 10 created revision timetables making sure that they create positive habits, ensuring that they have the best chance in achieving amazing GCSE results. Finally, year 11 investigated strategies to support them in preparing and completing their Prelims, as well as, looking into barriers that are stopping them from achieving greatness.

What can you do to support your child's character development?

Encourage Responsibility: Why not, if you haven't already, assign age-appropriate chores and responsibilities for your child to do at home. This will foster a sense of accountability, it teaches personal responsibility, and contributes to a strong work ethic. Possible chores could include vacuuming, taking the recycling and rubbish out, washing the dishes, weeding and gardening, taking care of pets (feeding, walking, cleaning), helping younger siblings with homework or school projects. We would encourage you **NOT** to pay them for completing these tasks.
